*Our season runs from approximately the mid/end of May till mid/end of October (approximately 20 weeks +/-) weather and season dependent. As a member, I commit myself to supporting the Bergefurd Family farm with my ideas, input, and membership share. I understand that as a member of the CSA I will receive:

_____ Option 1: a weekly full (1 bushel) Share of produce (an average of 4-7 items per week) at \$500/share/about 20 weeks (about \$25 a week)

_____ Option 2: a weekly half (1/2 bushel) Share of produce (an average of 4-7 items per week) at \$250/share/about 20 weeks (about \$12.50 a week).

_____ Option 3: Partial season full Share of produce (an average of 4-7 items per week) at \$250/share/10 weeks (about \$25 a week).

_____ Option 4: Partial season half Share of produce (an average of 4-7 items per week) at \$150/share/10 weeks (about \$12.50 a week).

Bergefurd Farm CSA Application Form (con't)

* Memberships may be split into 2 payments, half at time of application and the other half with a check dated by March 1, 2010. Make check payable to **Bergefurds Farm Market**.

* I understand that if I or my representative do not pick up my share it will be given to the needy at a local food bank. I do not expect to have my share saved.

*I understand the harvest shares will vary in size and weight with the season, lightest early and late in the season, and heaviest mid season. I understand that the types of produce available will vary with the time of season (see attached *Ohio* produce availability chart).

* I understand that the varieties of produce and quantities listed are approximations of the produce I will receive and is highly dependent on growing conditions, weather, rainfall, disease and insect outbreaks and other production factors that vary from season to season and that the risks and benefits of the harvest are shared (see attached sheet for produce planted).

*I understand that I am investing in a fertile local farm that is dependent on normal weather conditions to be most productive. There is some risk of crop failure, which we attempt to minimize by growing a wide variety of crops, succession cropping, continued planting of crops, using raised beds for drainage and irrigation of our crops, however Mother Nature determines the final harvest if any.

*I understand that there will be no refunds.

*Bergefurd Farm agrees to make all reasonable efforts to protect your investment in the 2010 crop and to deliver your share to the designated pickup site at the scheduled dates and times. If delivery times need to be changed due to unforeseen circumstances, all members affected will be notified in advance of such changes.

* I understand that all of the produce is selectively hand harvested, but it is still possible that some insects, weather lesions and soil may be present, especially in rainy weather. It is your responsibility to wash thoroughly all of the produce you receive before consumption. All produce is packed immediately after picking right out of the field.

*I understand that the reusable bushel or ½ bushel bags are intended only for use while transporting the produce from the pick up site to my home and then must be returned to Bergefurd Farm the following week.

*I understand that home grown produce unlike shipped in produce is not always uniform in quality and appearance.

*I understand the produce has **NOT** been treated with fungicides after harvest and/or at shipping like much conventional shipped in grocery store produce and simple bruising during transporting can result in spoiling.

*Our family of pickers attempt to remove badly damaged produce before it is packed, however, some may unintentionally get placed in your basket occasionally. It is my right to call Marcia Bergefurd at (937)383-2133 or (937)302-7908, or e-mail marcia@bergefurdsfarmmarket.com and inform the Bergefurd Family if this happens and replacement will be negotiated.

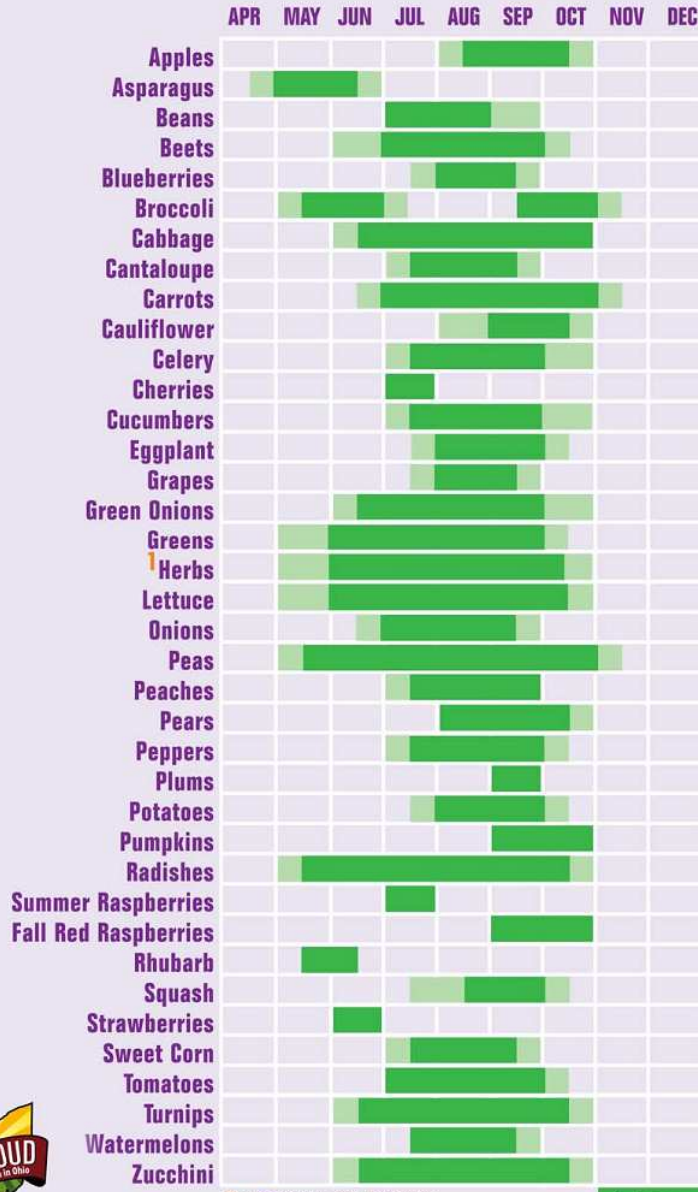
