Welcome to the Bergefurd Family 2012 Community Supported Agriculture (CSA). Shares are sold on a first come first served basis and are available until we are sold out. Check the "Pick up day & locations" section of this form to make sure that there is a pick up site and day that suits you. Then you can read, fill out, sign and mail back this application form with check(s) payable to **Bergefurds Farm Market** for the share and purchase amount you choose and mail it with your application form to us. After receiving your application form and payment we will contact you within 8 weeks by e-mail or phone to confirm your pick up location and day. We also will let you know when crop harvest begins via our weekly in season CSA Friends newsletter so that we may begin serving you!

### **Bergefurd Family Farm Community Supported Agriculture Program Application Form**

\*Our season runs from approximately June through October (approximately 20 weeks) weather and season dependent. As a member, I commit myself to supporting the Bergefurd family farm with my ideas, input, and membership share. I understand that as a member of the CSA I will receive:

\_\_\_\_\_ Option 1: a weekly full share of produce (approx. 1 bushel size with an average of 4 to 10 items per week or more) at \$550/share/about 20 weeks ~June through October (about \$27.50 a week)

\_\_\_\_\_ Option 2: a weekly half share of produce (approx. 1/2 bushel size with an average of 4 to 10 items per week or more) for \$300/share/about 20 weeks ~June through October (about \$15 a week).

## **Bergefurd Family Farm CSA Application Form (con't)**

\* Memberships can be paid with a single payment or may be split into 2 payments, half at time of application and the other half with a check post dated by February 1, 2012. Make check(s) payable to **Bergefurds Farm Market**. Include both checks with your application the post dated check WILL NOT be cashed till February 1, 2012.

\* I understand that if I or my representative do not pick up my share it will be given to the needy at a local food bank. I do not expect to have my share saved.

\*I understand that only with at least a 24 hour advanced notice I can change my share pick up location for a particular week.

\*I understand the harvest shares will vary in size, weight and amount with the season, lightest early and late in the season, and heaviest mid season. I understand that the types of produce available will vary with the time of season (see attached *Ohio* produce availability chart).

\* I understand that the varieties of produce and quantities listed are approximations of the produce I will receive and is highly dependent on growing conditions, weather, rainfall, disease and insect outbreaks and other production factors that vary from season to season and that the risks and benefits of the harvest are shared (see attached sheet for produce planted).

\*I understand that all shareholders receive the same variety of produce and I cannot choose what goes in my bag.

\*I understand that I am investing in a fertile local farm that is dependent on normal weather conditions to be most productive. There is some risk of crop failure, which we attempt to minimize by growing a wide variety of crops, succession cropping, continued planting of crops, using raised beds for drainage and irrigation of our crops, however Mother Nature determines the final harvest if any.

\*I understand that there will be no refunds.

\*Bergefurd Family Farm agrees to make all reasonable efforts to protect your investment in the 2012 crop and to deliver your share to the designated pickup site at the scheduled dates and times. If delivery times need to be changed due to unforeseen circumstances, all members affected will be notified in advance of such changes.

\* I understand that all of the produce is selectively hand harvested, but it is still possible that some insects, weather lesions and soil may be present, especially in rainy weather. It is your responsibility to wash thoroughly all of the produce you receive before consumption. All produce is packed into shares soon after picking right out of the field.

\*I understand that the reusable share bags are intended only for use while transporting produce from my pickup site to my home and then must be returned to Bergefurd Family Farm the following week.

\*I understand that home grown produce unlike shipped in produce is not always uniform in quality, appearance and size.

**Bergefurd Family Farm CSA Application Form (con't)**

\*I understand the produce has **NOT** received post harvest treatments of fungicides, insecticides, fumigants or waxes after harvest and/or at shipping like much conventional shipped in grocery store produce and simple bruising during transporting can result in spoiling.

\*Our family of pickers attempt to remove badly damaged produce before it is packed, however, some may unintentionally get placed in your bag or be damaged in transit occasionally. It is my right to call Marcia Bergefurd at (937)383-2133 or (937)302-7908, or e-mail [bergefurdsfarmmarket@yahoo.com](mailto:bergefurdsfarmmarket@yahoo.com) within 24 hours of pick up and inform the Bergefurd Family if this happens and replacement will be negotiated.
